### **Job Description**

This internship is responsible for creating and publishing an inspiring and accurate StoryMap that will live on the Conservancy's website. The focus of this project is looking back at the interns who have taken on important work each summer since 2014 for both the Conservancy and National Park Service. Connecting with these interns to learn where they are now and how their experience as an intern in the Riverway affected their career trajectory.

Investigation, writing, and editing skills will be essential for the success of this internship.

This StoryMap will be shared with donors (individual, business, and foundation), colleges for intern recruitment, and interested interns themselves to show the impact this program has and inspire additional support.

The day-to-day supervisor is the Communications & Marketing Coordinator.

### **Position Details**

This is a temporary, \$15 per hour, part-time internship ranging 10-15 hours weekly for a minimum of 12 weeks.

- The internship will be based at the picturesque Wild Rivers Conservancy office in Osceola, WI, with remote work options available.
- Hours per week are negotiable, varying between 10 and 15 hours each week
